PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS, FEATURES & BENEFITS

In response to a higher level of community involvement and in effort to encourage engagement within the city, Harrisburg Police Department filled the void by adding the Allison Hill Police Substation. In collaboration with SGS Architects, a contemporary and logical space was designed to meet the needs of the local community and law enforcement officials.

Built at MODLOGIQ's facility in only 17 weeks and set-up within a day, this building was delivered with a completed architectural thin sliced brick that provided both a functional and aesthetically pleasing exterior that doubled as a protection for occupants and safety measure for outside threats, the design team implemented Level 3 ballistic rated walls and roofing.

By choosing off-site construction, Harrisburg was able to address the importance of cost effectiveness, eliminate concerns of lacking lay-down area for construction materials, and leverage our "Build-Together" process to provide a greener construction site by reducing on-site workers, heating/power, and equipment emissions.
